- 5. Predator Free Tamahere

- Jane Morgan outlined the aims and work done so far by this new community group.
- To provide monthly updates.

6. Service Delivery – Tamahere Community Committee Issues Report – Circulated

- Better Off Funding and TCC concerns around communication For November
- Birchwood Lane Speeds survey data avaiable next week.
- **Devine Rd/School Footpath** working with school principal, have organised a site visit
- Newell RD concrete barriers to remain in current place
- Tamahere bus stops in progress
- Woodcock Rd foot traffic no action until Dec.22.
- Pollock Reserve Signage target date for installation Late Oct/early Nov
 22
- Tamahere Park Dog use sporadic animal control patrols, additional signage being considered. No funding for off leash area until after next LTP. Dogs in park event being considered.
 - **Action;** Geoff to provide idea of costs and requirements for November.
- **EV Charger** adjacent to reserve carpark. 4 charging stations to be installed. Noted; Thankyou to Geoff and Cr Bech for their work on this.
 - Former Riff Raff Toilets HCC have provided a transfer of ownership agreement. No current funding for refurbishment, consenting and installation. Aksel to follow up as budget for this refurb was to come from the new toilet upgrade budget.
 - Existing Toilet upgrade installation scheduled for March 23

7. Cr Bech Report - circulated

- **CCTV** funding application made through WDC via DIA under the Better Off Funding grants. If approved will be for full amount.
- **Bylaws and Policies reviews** Policies Local Alcohol Policy Hearing heard. To be signed off this week.
- **Council Elections** voting returns behind 2 prior elections.
- **Tamahere Park** The celebration for Stage went well with a full school turn-out -a good occasion with all sponsors of seats etc also acknowledged.
- Riff Raff Toilets secured from HCC. I note Geoff's report that there are no funds currently available; I will remind WDC that funding for 2 x 2-pan blocks is secured and with now just one required from new (to replaced the leased one), the second one now only requiring a refurb should all be within existing budgets.
- **EV Chargers** ChargeNet and WDC have now agreed the overall terms of their agreement, including a 15 year license to occupy a piece of road reserve (for the charging infrastructure), a new location in the main WDC carpark (opposite playground, on road side) and now for 4-car charging facility rather than the 2-car previously contemplated.
