## 5. SH21 Underpass Update – Matt Kofoed (Downers)

Now Level 3 so work is reduced. Work slowly proceeding on Church side of SH26.

#### 6. Safety and Connectivity Report

Sarah Loynes (Waka Kotahi) expects to have a draft report with recommendations ready by next week.

#### 7. <u>Cr Bech Report</u>

- Tamahere Park/Piazza 6 benches installed by Lions with thanks. Cr Bech to raise funds for 2 more to close of vehicle access to the playing fields. WDC have completed bollard installation at the skatepark end. Tenders for stage build being reviewed. Fitness pad equipment with Cr Bech to progress.
- **E Charger at Hub** agreement for a 'license to occupy' and exclusive use of 2 carparks being reviewed now.
- Consultations Representation Review final proposal has been notified with TCC submission accepted in part with the 'horseshoe' area abandioned in favour of a two councillor ward named Tamahere-Woodlands. Final proposals automatically go to the Electoral Commission. TCC has until Nov 3<sup>rd</sup> to appeal or object. TCC remains in favour of a single councilor ward. Further submission to this effect to be drafted and lodged.

**Motion;** That a subcommittee of Leo, Sue and Charles work up an appeal to the two councillor ward proposal.

• **3 Waters** – WDC has submitted its feedback on the proposed reforms but have not been asked to make the opt in/opt out decision.

Committee has serious reservations about the reforms and the shape of them.

**Motion;** TCC invites WDC councillors to opt out of the current proposal. The committee is opposed to the proposition noting asset ownership, governance and accountability as significant concerns. TCC to advise Mayor and Councillors of this decision.

# 8. Service Delivery – Tamahere Community Committee Issues Report - Circulated and accepted as read

Thanks to Geoff for his prompt answering of hall and targeted rates questions.

- New Cultural Reserve and Dogs land owned and managed by Waka Kotahi with a maintenance agreement with Ngati Haua. No decision on dog exercise here.
- Bins at Tamahere Village Citycare support additional bin. Cost (\$3000 not budgeted for). Standard bins \$1700. Suggested Citycare nominate a place for it.

**Action;** Cr Bech to check whether 4Square will pay for a bin near them.

- Wiremu Tamihana Drive fence There is provision within next years budget to replace the exisiting farm type fence. An assessment needs to be done to ascertain the replacement type.
- Hall Targeted Rate\_- 2017/18 loan of \$500,000 forecast to be repaid June 2022.

  Targeted rate of \$70 applies to 1358 properties in 2020/21. Once loan is repaid and hall budgets defined, TCC can review the Targeted Rate and request and consult on continuing it at the current \$70 per property if a case can be made for further community benefits elsewhere.

Hall insured with AON for 2.19m, annual premium \$3235.00

- Tamahere Park & Fitness Trail soak area fencing has been repaired, No 3 fitness pad is underway.
- Tamahere Park Pavillion Tenders close for construction contract closed on Sept.30<sup>th</sup>. Building consent has been issued.
- **Anne brook Rd**\_- SH1 access road now closed. A quote is out for the construction of a turning head at SH 1 end. Physical work planned to be complete by Nov 30<sup>th</sup> 2021.
- Tamahere Park Toilets 6 8 week delay as a design review takes place with the projected outcomes of reduced construction costs and long term maintenance. Consultation with key stakeholders to take place as soon as design drawings are available. Staff have noted TCC's preference for a 30 degree pitch roof as per the reserve development design guide.

Using the toilets as a possible structure to mount CCTV cameras was discussed.

**Action**; Geoff to check whether camera mounting and power and data connectivity is possible.

## **CCTV** Subcommittee

- Public feedback 6 responses only, all in favour.
- WDC will cover the cost but doesn't want to manage it.
- Recent theft of playground equipment and 5 breakins support CCTV.
- Onsite meeting has happened with Cr Bech and contract provider.
- No feedback from WDC as to the specifics needed to set this up with NZ Police.
- Siteing of cameras on new toilet block has been discussed with Geoff King and WDC.
- Commercial signage poles could provide another camera siteing option.
- Proposed playground shading may affect camera sight lines.

# <u>Dropbox Upgrade</u>

- The free dropbox storage managed by the secretary is at capacity.
- Next level upgrade to 2000GB proposed at an annual cost of US\$137.86
