Report Title	Council Representative to the Appointments Panel for the Woodlands Historic Trust Board		

## I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

As its meeting of I November, Council appointed Peter De Luca as the representative to the Woodlands Historic Trust Board. Following changes to the Trust Deed this appointment is no longer valid. Council is eligible to appoint a representative to the Appointments Panel for the Trust Board. It is suggested that the Chief Executive be appointed to this role.

## 2. **RECOMMENDATION**

**THAT** the report from the Chief Executive be received;

AND THAT pursuant to schedule 7 clause 32 of the Local Government Act 2002 the Waikato District Council appoints the Chief Executive as the Council representative to the Woodlands Historic Trust Board Appointment Panel;

AND FURTHER THAT it be noted that Council does not make a direct appointment to the Trust Board following change to the Trust Deed. As a result the appointment of Peter De Luca is therefore no longer required.

## 3. BACKGROUND

The Council, in line with previous practice, appointed Peter De Luca as its representative to the Woodlands Historic Trust Board in November.

# 4. DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS OF OPTIONS

### 4.1 DISCUSSION

Following changes to the Trust Deed there is now no direct appointments to the Trust Board. Appointments are instead made by an Appointments Panel established by the Trust Deed.

Peter De Luca, the previous Council representative to the Trust Board is the Chair of the Appointments Panel. All members of the Panel are voting members and there is no casting vote.

#### 4.2 **OPTIONS**

The Council is entitled to appoint a representative to the Appointments Panel. This will enable Council's overall interest in the Woodlands reserve to be considered in the appointments process.

Council still owns the property and has a lease agreements with the Trust which secures Council's position and interests.

Council could choose to appoint a representative or not.

The Appointments Panel already comprises people with gardening and reserves experience (Hamilton City Representative), Commerical and Trust experience (Peter De Luca), Trust and local knowledge (Arthur Riddell and John Bridgman).

It is suggested that the Chief Executive be appointed as the Council representative.
