2	THE FOLLOWING 'ROADSIDE FENCING GUIDELINES' SHALL APPLY TO FENCES LOCATED ON THE ROAD RESERVE:					
	(a)	On strategic, arterial and collector roads, fences shall generally be on the boundary.				
	(b)	On local roads, the fence may be located on road reserve to a minimum distance of 4 metres from the carriageway or I metre from the watertable, except if approved otherwise by the General Manager Service Delivery.				
	(c)	Fence locations shall take into account the existing road width and possible widening over a 10-15 year period.				
	(d)	In rolling and hill country, fences may be located no closer than 1.2 metres to the top of batters.				
	(e)	Recognition shall be made for provision of other services in the roadway and for others travelling off the carriageway.				
Ó	Where the landowner does not accept the decision on the location of the fence, the landowner may request the decision to be reviewed by an appeal panel comprising the General Manager Service Delivery, Infrastructure Committee Chairperson and the Ward member for that area.
