- Federated Farmers of New Zealand Incorporated (Federated Farmers) wishes to be a party to the proceedings ENV-2022-AKL-000048 (the Proceedings).
- 2. Federated Farmers made a submission about the subject matter of the Proceedings. Federated Farmers also has an interest in the proceedings that is greater than the interest that the general public has as a representative body for farmers' interests which may be affected by the relief sought by the Appellant. Additionally:
  - (a) the subject matter of the appeal is a matter of interest to farmers who rely on natural and physical resources in the district in making their livelihoods; and
  - (b) there is a potential for farmers in the district to be directly impacted by the terms of the appeal.
- Federated Farmers is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- 4. Federated Farmers is interested in parts of the Proceedings which relate to:
  - the addition of new permitted and restricted discretionary rules to the AINF (All Infrastructure) chapter to apply in all zones;
  - (b) showing an effects area of 100m for noise and 40m for vibration on the planning maps; and
  - (c) any consequential relief sought by the Appellant to give effect to these matters.
- 5. Federated Farmers is interested in the issue of restricting activities in the vicinity of state highways in rural areas.

- 6. Federated Farmers opposes the relief sought because:
  - (a) of the limited noise and vibration effects state highways have on sensitive land use in rural areas; and
  - (b) the relief sought by the Appellant may unnecessarily restrict farming activity without any environmental benefit.
- 7. Federated Farmers agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
