Te Ao Maaori, te kaawai runga me te kaawai raro: The Maaori world view where there are realms of the gods and realms of the people. 3. Taha wairua: the spiritual side. 4. Rangatiratanga: the mana of rangatira and their communities to make decisions regarding their resources. 5. Tohu: flora and fauna that provided indicators of river health and signs of safety. 6. Ngaa taniwha me ngaa tipua: metaphysical beings that are manifested in natural phenomenon - the river spirits. 7. Waahi tapu: places of spiritual power and cultural significance. 8. Wai: the use of water for rituals and ceremonies. 9. Ngaa koorero me ngaa mahi: knowledge and experiences. 10. Waiata me ngaa karakia: the modes that transmit knowledge and tikanga for the river. 	XX
