#### Od National Environmental Standards - Telecommunication Facilities

The National Environmental Standards for Telecommunications Facilities came into force on9 October 2008 under the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Telecommunications Facilities) Regulations 2008 ("NES"). The NES were created pursuant to section 43 of the Resource Management Act 1991.

The NES broadly state that -

- An activity (such as a mobile phone transmitter) that emits radio-frequency fields is a permitted activity provided it complies with the existing New Zealand Standard (NZS2772.1:1999 Radio-frequency Fields Part 1: Maximum Exposure Levels 3kHz-300GHz).
- The installation of telecommunications equipment cabinets in the road reserve is a permitted activity, subject to specified limitations on their size and location.
- Noise from telecommunications equipment cabinets located in the road reserve is a permitted activity, subject to specified noise limits.
- The installation of masts and antennas on existing structures in the road reserve is a permitted activity, subject to specified limitations to height and size.

This means that some telecommunications facilities may potentially be deployed as a permitted activity. However, telecommunications facilities which do not comply with the conditions within the Regulations will have the activity status set under Regulation 5, which in most cases reverts to the district plan provisions. Therefore, the relevant rules of the district plan remain applicable, as only equipment which completely complies with the Regulations is a permitted activity.

The rules within the Plan regarding telecommunication facilities have been referenced to this Appendix Od as from 9 October 2008. The NES are interpreted and compared with the District Plan rules and are reprinted here within a matrix to assist plan users. For full context, it is necessary to refer to the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Telecommunications Facilities) Regulations 2008.

This Appendix has been inserted in the District Plan pursuant to Clause 16(1) of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991.
