**1: Huntly Domain**

- Redevelop a destination playground.
- Remove toilet block and wall and replace with a new toilet located between the playground and sports field.
- Create a shared space with the existing skate park
- Upgrade park to include redeveloped playground, parking, seating, picnic tables and rubbish bin.
- Proposed Specimen trees to provide shade, seasonal interest and define the entrance to the Domain.
- Install new road signs to indicate new 1-way system.
- Install viewing platform as an extension from the existing rotunda.

**2: Huntly Domain - Waterfront**

- Reconfigure existing carpark and create a combined car park to cater for increased visitor numbers.
- One way road into parking bay with angle parking and new toilet.
- Proposed boardwalk connection linking existing platform to the Yacht Club Jetty. Boardwalk to be 2.5m wide.
- Install retaining to protect the lake edge.
- Relocate existing toilet to a more appropriate placement.
- Install new road signs to indicate 1-way system.

**3: MacMillan Walkway**

- Raise walkway and/or boardwalk for all season access.
- Native wetland restoration planting
- Undertaken waterway enhancement works
- Install new shelter structure

**4: Lake Edge**

- Install new platforms to extend beyond marginal planting.
- Investigate and install lake planting into lake, extent to be determined from water quality recommendations.
- Install lake erosion control measures.

**5: Wetland**

- Develop area in conjunction with landowner to develop a restoration programme for wetland.

**6: Raahui Pookeka Gardens/ Genesis Energy Gardens**

- Allow for a sealed carpark and toilet.
- Create themed areas and improve walkway connections, completing Friends of Lake Hakanoa design.

**7: Green Cathedral**

- Manage existing vegetation by thinning/pruning to retain visibility and improve safety along walkway.

**8: Entrance**

- Remove trees and redefine entrance.
- Install gates and bollards along Wight Street to create a threshold
- Install one-way directions signs
